Houston, TX, June 14, 2010. Over 1,400 players took the field for Albion Hurricanes FC (AHFC) Fall 2010 Tryouts and Player Evaluation event which concluded the week of June 7 – 10, 2010. The tryouts were held for AHFC's Main and West campus at three venues: the AHFC Campbell Road complex, Katy Park and Bear Creek Park. These Tryouts marked the largest and most successful Tryouts in AHFC history.

Additionally, Signing Day was held to streamline the Player Registration process and provide the players and parents to view the new AHFC Gear and Adidas uniforms. Players also had the opportunity to complete the registration process on-line if preferred.
