This marks the 3<sup>rd</sup> consecutive year that AHFC is the leader in Houston which is a tremendous accomplishment. Congratulations to the AHFC 95B Blue, AHFC 96B Blue, AHFC 96G Blue A, AHFC 96G Blue B, AHFC 94G Blue, AHFC 92G Blue and AHFC 92G Black for their achievement.

AHFC 92G Blue have qualified to represent South Texas at the USYS National Cup Regional Championships in Baton Rouge, LA in late June.

*"This is a great way for our senior girls to finish at the club. Most of the girls have been with us for a number of years and to sign off at Regional Championships is a great reward for their efforts and commitment over those years"* said Daniel Hill, AHFC Girls Director. AHFC 92G Blue will face the best U18 Girls teams from Region 3 as they attempt to advance to National Championships in July.

In addition the AHFC 94G Black team has advanced to the Regional Championships at the President's Cup level. The AHFC 94G Black finished first out of four teams at the State Championships held in San Antonio. Regional Championships will be held in Broken Arrow, OK, June 10-14<sup>th</sup>, 2010. AHFC 94G Black will face the State Champions in President's Cup from all over Region 3 which covers the south states from Texas to North Carolina, hoping to emulate our AHFC 94G Blue W last year and advance to President's Cup National Championships.
